## **Townsend Information**

Mustang Motel 406/266-3491

Rates when I checked were \$45 for single room; \$51 for double. It's a small "old fashioned" motel (think 1960's vintage)

## **Camping facilities near Townsend**

There is plenty of room for camping at the Broadwater County Fairgrounds, and it's where our awards dinner will be after the shoot. These are "dry" campsites but there is a limited number of electrical hookups available for a \$15/night fee. Please leave your campsite in as good as shape as when you came – our county fair kicks off a couple of days after our event.

## **Other Townsend Info**

Our little town with Canyon Ferry Lake and the headwaters of the Missouri River offers abundant recreation opportunities for camping, fishing or boating.

More Townsend info - several restaurants in town – The Mint, Betsy's Kitchen, Hwy 12 Café, The Fish Tale tavern, The Commercial Bar, and Full Belly Deli. There's two gas station/convenience stores – Town Pump and Rocky Mountain Supply. At Rocky Mountain, you'll find clothing, supplies for camping, fishing and hardware. For groceries we have Bob's Food Market and for other supplies, Townsend Drug. We also have a couple of excellent quilt shops if someone comes with you with that interest!

## **Hotels in Three Forks, MT, approximately 35 miles away**

Fork Three Forks Motel 406/285-3233

Rates when I checked started at \$91.

This hotel also has 12 RV sites with full hookups.

Broken Spur Motel 406/285-3237

Rates when I checked started at \$80

Sacawjawa Hotel 406/285-6515

A historic restored Inn featuring more luxurious accommodations

When I called I was informed that no reservations could be made more than 30 days out. A variety of options are offered – rooms start at \$175/night and they also have cabins that sleep 4 for \$400/night

There's a fine dining restaurant, Pompey's Grill, also the Sac Bar featuring live music on weekends.

## **Hotels in Helena, approximately 35 miles away**

Any of the wellknown hotel chains are available in Helena, although be aware that this is the same weekend as their county fair and rodeo – Last Chance Stampede.
